In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 2(1) of the Pensions Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice:

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Pensions (Allowances) Notice, 1989.

Pensionable Allowances.

2. The allowances specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto are included in the pensionable emoluments of the officers holding the pensionable offices specified opposite in the second column of the Schedule.

Revocation.

3. The Pensions (Special Allowances) Notices in force on the day immediately preceding the commencement of this notice are revoked.

Any allowance which has been included under section 2(1) from time to time in an officer's pensionable emoluments and paid to him during his pensionable service shall continue to be so included notwithstanding that it may have been revoked by, or before the commencement of this notice. Provided that for the purpose of this paragraph the allowances of any description specified in the Schedule and marked with an asterisk shall be deemed to have been included in the pensionable emoluments of an officer with effect from the date shown against that description of allowance.
