1. These regulations may be cited as the Litter Control (Forms and Notices) Regulations 1990.

Designation Orders.

- 2.(1) Where a Litter Authority proposes to issue a designation order under sub-section (3) of section 7 of the Act, the notification required by subsection (5) of that section shall be in the form prescribed in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to these regulations.
- (2) Where a Litter Authority issues a designation order under section 7(3) of the Act, such order shall be in the form prescribed in Part 2 of Schedule 1 of these regulations.

Litter Abatement Notice.

- 3.(1) Where a Litter Authority serves a notice in accordance with section 9(1) of the Act, such notice (a "litter abatement notice") shall be in the form prescribed in Part 1 of Schedule 2 to these regulations.
- (2) Where a Litter Authority proposes to exercise its powers of removal under section 9(6) of the Act, a notice in the form prescribed in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to these regulations shall be issued.

LITTER CONTROL ACT 1990

- (i) Any representations made by you shall be taken into account by the Litter Authority in making their decision.
- (ii) It shall be the duty of the occupier or owner of any relevant land within a litter control area to ensure that the said land is kept clear of litter and refuse.
- (iii) Failure to maintain the land clear of refuse and litter may result in a litter abatement notice being served imposing either or both of the following
 - (a) a requirement that the litter or refuse be cleared within a time specified in the notice;

(b) the prohibition on permitting land to be defaced by litter or refuse.

(iv) Failure to comply with the said notice may lead, on summary conviction, to a fine at level 4 on the standard scale and to a further fine of one twentieth of the amount at level 4 on the standard scale for each day on which the offence continues after conviction.

WHEREAS the Litter Authority is satisfied that the above-mentioned land, being land designated under section 7(3) of the Litter Control Act 1990, as, or as part of, a litter control area, is defaced by litter or refuse or defacement by litter or refuse is likely to recur:

- (i) The person served with this notice may appeal against the notice to the Magistrates' Court within the period of seven days beginning with the date on which the notice was served.
- (ii) A person who, without reasonable excuse, fails to comply with or contravenes the requirements of the notice, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the amount at level 4 on the standard scale and to a further fine of one twentieth of the amount at level 4 on the standard

(iii) If any person fails to comply with this notice, the Litter Authority may, where it considers it necessary in the interests of the amenities of the neighbourhood, remove the litter or refuse in respect of which the notice was issued and any person subsequently convicted in this respect shall be liable to the Authority for the reasonable cost of such removal.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN YOU that the Litter Authority consider it necessary in the interests of the amenities of the neighbourhood to remove the litter or refuse in respect of which the notice was issued and, in accordance with section 9(6) of the Litter Control Act 1990, shall, by their authorised representatives, remove the said litter or refuse on

and the cost of so doing shall be recoverable from you in accordance with section 9(6) of that Act.

NOTES:

Any person subsequently convicted under section 9(5) of the Litter Control Act 1990 for failure to comply with the requirements of a litter abatement notice in respect of this litter or refuse shall be liable to the Litter Authority for the reasonable cost of such removal, in addition to such fine, not exceeding the amount at level 4 on the standard scale, as the court may impose for failure to comply with the said notice.
