In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 11 of the Currency Notes Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State, has made the following rules—

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Currency Notes (Demonetisation) Rules 2000.

Demonetisation

2. All currency notes issued by the Government of Gibraltar of the following denominations and carrying the following prefix letters, shall cease to be current or legal tender in Gibraltar from and after 1st day of November, 2000.

£5 currency notes with the prefix letter E;

£10 currency notes with the prefix letter A;

£20 currency notes with the prefix letter A;

£50 currency notes with the prefix letter A.
