In exercise of his powers under paragraph 12C of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Order, the Minister makes the following Notice-

#### Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Designation of Parking Spaces in 6/8 Scud Hill Notice 2007.

#### Parking Spaces in 6/8 Scud Hill.

2. The parking spaces delineated by markings on the ground are designated as spaces to which paragraph 12C of the Parking and Waiting Order applies.

#### Permits.

- 3.(1) Only those cars issued with a valid parking permit may park in the designated spaces.
- (2) A permit may be issued by the Minister and is valid for one year from the date of issue; it may be renewed each year.

- (3) A permit is not transferable and if the owner of the car which the permit was issued becomes non-resident of 6/8 Scud Hill or sells or otherwise disposes of the car the permit must be returned to the Minister; the Minister may issue a replacement permit, valid for the remainder of the term of the original permit, if the owner of the car replaces it with another car.
- (4) The Minister may issue a replacement permit, valid for the remainder of the term of the original permit, if the original permit is lost or defaced.
