In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3 of the Pensions Act, and all other enabling powers, and after approval by resolution of the Parliament, the Government has made the following Regulations—

#### Title and application.

These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and shall be applied from 1 January 2001.

#### Pensions for non-pensionable officers.

2. Non-pensionable officers under the Pensions Act shall, for the purpose of retirement on medical grounds, death in service and retirement as a consequence of injury at work or as a result of contracting a disease in the discharge of their duties, have the right to be treated as if he or she were an officer in a pensionable office and receive the same pension and gratuity as an officer in a pensionable office with the same amount of pensionable service. No service below the age of 18 shall be treated as pensionable service.
