Notices affixed to a vehicle pursuant to regulation 48(2) shall follow substantially the following form–

“TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) REGULATIONS 2011

STOP!

1. This illegally-parked vehicle has been immobilised by a wheel-clamp pursuant to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.
2. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE IT.** No attempt should be made to drive this vehicle or otherwise put it in motion, until the vehicle has been duly released from such wheel-clamp.
3. It is an offence to remove, or attempt to remove or otherwise interfere with the wheel-clamp.
4. As the owner or person in charge of this vehicle, you should seek its release. To do this, you must–
 - (a) detach this label and take it with you to Gibraltar Car Parks Ltd, Unit II, 45 North Mole Road, Gibraltar; and
 - (b) pay a fee of £60.00.
