In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 22 of the Mutual Legal Assistance (European Union) Act 2005 and all other enabling powers the Chief Justice has made the following Rules—

Title and Commencement.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Mutual Legal Assistance (European Union) Rules 2012 and come into operation on publication in the Gazette.

Court to receive evidence - Exclusion of Public.

2. Where a court is to receive evidence under section 14 of the Mutual Legal Assistance (European Union) Act 2005 (court to receive evidence), the court may direct that the public be excluded from those proceedings if it thinks it necessary to do so in the interests of justice.
