FOR

AN ACT to amend the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee (Amendment) (No.2) Act 2010 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of section 18 of the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee Act.

2. Section 18 of the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee Act is amended by substituting for subsection (3)–

“(3) A permit of residence shall only be issued under the provisions of subsection (1)(f)–

- (a) if the Principal Immigration Officer is satisfied that the applicant, or the parent of an applicant under the age of eighteen or the spouse of the applicant, holds a valid certificate of employment issued under the provisions of section 25 of the Employment Act and is employed in Gibraltar; or
 - (b) in accordance with rules which may be made by the Government for this purpose.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill amends the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee Act to enable the Government to make rules providing for the issue of residence permits under section 18(1)(f) of that Act.
