FOR

AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act 2005.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Act 2013 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 September 2013.

Amendment of the Traffic Act 2005.

2. Section 34 of the Traffic Act 2005 is amended as follows—

- (a) in subsection (3) for the words “A learner’s licence” substitute the words “Subject to subsection (3A), a learners licence”;
- (b) after subsection (3) insert the following subsection—

“(3A) A learner’s licence issued to a person who has obtained a CBT Certificate under the Traffic (Compulsory Basic Test) Regulations 2013, shall be valid for 15 months from the date of issue:

Provided that where the holder of a learner’s licence is disqualified from holding or obtaining a driving licence his learner’s licence shall thereupon cease to have effect.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill amends the Traffic Act 2005 to extend the period of validity of a learner's licence which has been obtained following the issue of a CBT Certificate under the Traffic (Compulsory Basic Test) Regulations 2013.
