FOR

AN ACT to amend the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) Act 1996

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) (Amendment) Act 2008 and shall be deemed to have into operation on 1 April 2008.

Amendment of Act.

- 2. The Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) Act 1996 is amended—
 - (a) in section 5(2) and (3) on each occasion the word "weekly" appears substitute "monthly";
 - (b) in section 7A(3) for "weekly" substitute "monthly";
 - (c) in section 12A(3) for "weekly" substitute "monthly";
 - (d) in section 15(1) for "weekly" substitute "monthly";
 - (e) in section 16–
 - (i) for "weekly" substitute "monthly";

- (ii) in paragraph (a) for "weekly earnings" substitute "monthly earnings" and for "£39.48" substitute "£178.51";
- (f) in section 31(2) delete the words ", so that payments shall not be made in respect of periods less than a week or at different rates for different parts of a week";
- (g) by substituting the following for Schedule 1-
