# **BILL**

#### **FOR**

**AN ACT** to appropriate further sums of money to the service of the year ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 2010.

**E**NACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (2009/2010) Act 2010 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

## Consolidated Fund appropriation of recurrent expenditure 2009/2010.

- 2.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010, a further sum not exceeding £2,800,000.
- (2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Act.

#### Consolidated Fund appropriation of exceptional expenditure 2009/2010.

- 3.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010, a further sum not exceeding £772,000.
- (2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Act.

#### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

The purpose of this Bill is to appropriate further sums of money to the service of the year ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 2010.

#### Recurrent Consolidated Fund Expenditure

An estimated £1.8 million is required towards financing an increase in the contribution to the Social Assistance Fund.

A further  $\pounds 1.0$  million is required towards financing an increase in the contribution to the Gibraltar Health Authority.

## Consolidated Fund Exceptional Expenditure

An estimated £406,000 is required towards the expenditure incurred in connection with the Tribunal under Section 64 of the Constitution. A further £366,000 is required to fund the expenditure incurred in connection with the Swine Flu pandemic.
