FOR

AN ACT to appropriate sums of money to the service of the year ending on the 31st day of March 2020.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 2019 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Consolidated Fund Appropriation of Expenditure 2019/2020.

2.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31^{st} March 2020, a sum not exceeding £549,243,000.

(2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Act.

Consolidated Fund Appropriation of Contributions 2019/2020.

3.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31^{st} March 2020, a sum not exceeding £35,001,000.

(2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Act.

Application of sums voted for Supplementary Provision.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, the Minister responsible for finance may direct by means of a warrant that the whole or any part of the sums appropriated under Head 54 Supplementary Provision shall be applied to any of the other Heads specified in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule.

Improvement and Development Fund Appropriation of Expenditure 2019/2020.

5.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Improvement and Development Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31^{st} March 2020, a sum not exceeding £81,989,000.

(2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Act.

Recurrent Expenditure of Public Undertakings.

6.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Consolidated Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31st March 2020, a sum not exceeding $\pounds 279,685,000$.

(2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Act.

Capital Expenditure of Public Undertakings.

7.(1) The Accountant General may, under the authority of a general warrant issued in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance (Control and Audit) Act, pay out of the Improvement and Development Fund of Gibraltar for the year ending 31st March 2020, a sum not exceeding £9,666,000.

(2) The said sum shall be appropriated only to such purposes and shall not exceed such amounts as are set out in Part 5 of the Schedule to this Act.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this Bill is to appropriate sums of money necessary to meet Government expenditure for the year ending 31st day of March 2020.

Consolidated Fund Expenditure

The sum of $\pounds 584,244,000$ is required to fund expenditure from the Consolidated Fund as shown in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule.

Improvement and Development Fund Expenditure

The sum of $\pounds 81,989,000$ is required to fund expenditure from the Improvement and Development Fund as shown in Part 3 of the Schedule.

Recurrent Expenditure of Public Undertakings

The sum of $\pounds 279,685,000$ is required to fund recurrent expenditure of the Public Undertakings as shown in Part 4 of the Schedule. This expenditure is largely funded out of monies paid to the Public Undertakings from funds voted from the Consolidated Fund, as shown in Part 1 of the Schedule.

Capital Expenditure of Public Undertakings

The sum of £9,666,000 is required to fund capital expenditure of the Public Undertakings as shown in Part 5 of the Schedule. This expenditure is funded out of monies paid to the Public Undertakings from funds voted from the Improvement and Development Fund, as shown in Part 3 of the Schedule.
