FOR

AN Act to amend the Civil Aviation Act 2009 and the Aviation Security (EU Common Rules) Act 2011 and related secondary legislation.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Aviation (Amendment) Act 2012 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of the Civil Aviation Act 2009

2. In section 2(1) of the Civil Aviation Act 2009 for the definition of “the Minister” substitute-

““the Minister” means the Minister with responsibility for Civil Aviation;”.

Amendment of the Aviation Security (EU Common Rules) Act 2011

3. In section 2(1) of the Aviation Security (EU Common Rules) Act 2011 for the definition of “Minister” substitute-

““Minister” means the Minister with responsibility for Civil Aviation;”.

Amendment of related secondary legislation

4.(1) In regulation 2(1) of the Civil Aviation (Air Navigation) Regulations 2009 for the definition of “the Minister” substitute-

““the Minister” means the Minister with responsibility for Civil Aviation;”.

(2) In regulation 2(1) of the Civil Aviation (Investigation of Air Accidents and Incidents) Regulations 2009 for the definition of “the Minister” substitute-

““the Minister” means the Minister with responsibility for Civil Aviation;”.

Explanatory Memorandum

This Bill amends the Civil Aviation Act 2009 and the Aviation Security (EU Common Rules) Act 2011 and related secondary legislation following the decision to separate ministerial responsibility for civil aviation from the transport portfolio.
