INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

**CIVIL CONTINGENCIES ACT 2007 (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2013**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23(g)(ii) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act 2007 the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Contingencies Act 2007 (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment.

2. The Civil Contingencies Act 2007 is amended by inserting the following Part after Part 5—

“PART 6

Regulations.

31.(1) The Government may make regulations for the implementation of any European Union measure.

(2) Section 23(b) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act shall not apply to any penalty imposed in any regulations made under subsection (1).”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Civil Contingencies Act 2007 in order to provide powers for the making of subsidiary legislation for the implementation of rights and obligations arising out of the EU Treaties.
