## CIVILIANS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1993

*In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 7 of the Civilians Registration Act and of all other enabling powers, I have made the following regulations—*

### **Title and commencement.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Civilians Registration Regulations 1993 and shall come into effect on the 25th day of March 1993.

### **Registration.**

2. (1) Any person, other than a registered person, to whom these regulations apply shall, within three days of entry into Gibraltar, make application to the Registration Officer for registration in the appropriate form set out in Schedule 2 to the Act:

Provided that a person under the age of 15 years to whom paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Act applies, shall not be required to be registered separately from his parent or guardian but shall make application for registration within three days of attaining that age.

(2) Application for registration shall be made by any person to whom the Act becomes applicable within three days of the Act so becoming applicable to him.

(3) Every person making application for registration shall be photographed at such time and place as the Registration Officer may require.

### **Issue of card.**

3.(1) The Registration Officer on receiving a completed application for registration in respect of a person required to be registered shall, upon receipt of the registration fee of £5, issue to that person an identity card or a civilian registration card as the case may be.

(2) The identity card or civilian registration card issued in accordance with sub-regulation (1), shall contain the information entered in the register in respect of the holder of that card and shall be in the form specified by the Registration Officer.

Provided that where the holder of the card is under the age of 15 years at the date of issue of the card, the signature on the card shall be that of his parent or guardian.

4. A registered person shall, within three days of any change of the circumstances affecting any particulars required to be furnished by him to the Registration Officer in accordance with Schedule 2 to the Act, inform the Registration Officer accordingly and produce to the Registration Officer his card for such amendment as may be necessary.

#### **Loss or destruction of card.**

5. (1) If a card is lost, destroyed or defaced, the holder of the card shall immediately upon discovery of the loss, destruction or defacement report the fact to the Registration Officer, and, if so directed by that officer, shall apply for the issue of a new card in substitution therefor and shall pay the fee prescribed in regulation 3, and in the case of a defaced card, surrender the defaced card to that officer, whereupon that officer shall cause the substitute to be issued.

(2) No person shall destroy, deface or modify or seek to destroy, deface or modify a card.

(3) Any person who comes into possession of a card belonging to some other person whether by reason of the holder's death or otherwise, shall deliver or cause the card to be delivered to the Registration Officer as soon as may be.

#### **Validity of card.**

6.(1) Subject to sub-regulation (3) an identity card shall be valid from the date of issue for a period of ten years:

Provided that in the case of a person who is under the age of 15 years on the day on which the card is issued, the card shall expire on the date specified on the card.

(2) Subject to sub-regulation (3) a civilian registration card shall be valid from the date of issue until the date specified on the card as the date of expiry of that card.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-regulations (1) and (2), a card shall cease to be valid if the holder of the card ceases, in the case of an identity card, to be a person falling within paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Act or, in the case of a civilian registration card, to be a person falling within paragraph 3 of that Schedule.

#### **Penalties.**

7. Any person who commits any breach of these regulations shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine at level 1 on the standard scale and on a

second or subsequent conviction to imprisonment for one month or to a fine of twice the amount at level 1 on the standard scale.

### **Inspection of cards.**

8. Where in exercise of the powers contained in section 6(3) a person is required to produce his card, he shall produce it to the person so requiring production or to the Registration Officer at such location as the Registration Officer may require.

### **Revocation of Civilians Registration Regulations.**

9. The Civilians Registration Regulations are hereby revoked.
