AN ORDINANCE to amend the Companies Ordinance.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990.

New section 315.

2. The Companies Ordinance is amended by inserting a new section 315 as follows—

"European Economic Community Law.

315. (1) The Governor may make regulations to give effect in Gibraltar to the law of the European Economic Communities relating to any of the matters contained in this Ordinance, or having as its intention the regulation of companies and their affairs.

(2) Regulations made under this section may make provision for the repeal or modification of any provision of this Ordinance where such provision is

(a) in conflict with;

(b) made unclear by; or

(c) rendered unnecessary by,

a regulation made hereunder."
