Part I

The Certification

I hereby certify under and for the purposes of section 3 of the Construction (Government Projects) Act 2009, that it is necessary and desirable in the public interest that the construction works described in Part 2 below be executed and continued during restricted hours, subject to the conditions, restrictions and limitations set out in Part 3 below.

Part 2

Description of works

Works relating to the construction of the new air terminal building and associated landside and airside facilities, including a separate airside customs, cargo and ground support vehicle building which would be affected by airport safety operational rules.

Part 3

Conditions, restrictions and limitations

- i. The contractor is required to comply with any and all conditions or restrictions that may be imposed by the airport and other pertinent authorities, with construction work being undertaken within the defined working hours stipulated by the airport authority.
- ii. The contractor is required to employ all reasonable means for the suppression of noise and night time lighting, as stipulated in the Construction Environmental Management Plan.
