**AN ACT** to provide for transitional provisions in respect of amendments contained in the Supreme Court (Amendment) Act 2015.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title and commencement.**

1. This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court (Transitional Provision) Act 2015 and comes into operation on publication in the Gazette.

**Supreme Court (Amendment) Act 2015 – Transitional Provision.**

2. The Chief Justice may admit a person as a solicitor under section 29 of the Supreme Court Act (as amended by the Supreme Court (Amendment) Act 2015) if he is satisfied that such person—

- (a) on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015, had undertaken a period of no less than 12 months' training under a training contract approved by the Solicitors Regulation Authority of England and Wales as a trainee solicitor in Gibraltar; and
- (b) fulfils all the requirements for admission as a solicitor other than those contained in section 29(1)(ba) of the Supreme Court Act.
