SUPREME COURT ACT.

JURY (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1989.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 27 of the Supreme Court Act, and with the approval of the Governor, the Chief Justice has made the following rules.

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Jury (Amendment) Rules, 1989.

Revocation and replacement of Rule 18.

2. Rule 18 of the Jury Rules is revoked and the following rule is substituted therefor-

"Remuneration for Jury service.

18. (1) Where in consequence of his attendance a juror satisfies the Registrar at the termination of any trial that he has incurred any loss of earnings he shall be entitled to compensation equal to the amount of that loss.
- (2) Where a juror is unable to satisfy the Registrar at the termination of any trial of the actual amount of the loss of earnings which he has incurred then, subject to paragraph (3) of these Rules, he shall be entitled in respect of any one day to the following amount –
 - (a) where the period of time over which the loss is incurred does not exceed four hours, the sum of £10.00 or
 - (b) where the period of time exceeds four hours, the sum of £20.00.

- (3) Where, in obedience to a summons to serve on a jury, the juror has served on more than 15 days, and the Court so directs, the amount payable in respect of any one day after the fifteenth day may exceed £20.00 but shall not exceed £30.00."
