SUPREME COURT ACT

NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section I of the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act 1994, and after consultation with the Chief Justice, the Governor has issued the following notice -

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act (Notice of Commencement) Notice 1994.

Commencement of Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act 1994.

2. The 21 st day of July 1994 is appointed as the day on which all sections of the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act 1994 shall come into effect.

Transitional, incidental and supplementary provisions.

3. For the purpose of giving proper effect to the provisions of the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Act 1994, the Jury Rules made under the Supreme Court Act are amended as follows-

- (a) in rule I 1 by omitting the final fullstop and substituting therefor a semi-colon, the word "and" and the following proviso-

"Provided that where the court has ordered that an additional juror or additional jurors shall be chosen, references in this rule to nine or twelve jurors, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be references to such larger number as shall include the number of additional jurors ordered by the court to be chosen.";

- (b) in rule 12 by inserting after the word "case" the words "(which shall include any additional jurors chosen under the provisions of section 138 of the Criminal Procedure Act)";
- (c) in rule 18 by inserting after sub-rule (3) the following new sub-rule -

"(4) For the avoidance of doubt, in this rule "juror" includes additional juror."
