AN ORDINANCE to amend the Magistrates' Court Ordinance.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title and commencement.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Magistrates' Court (Amendment) Ordinance 1993 and shall come into effect on such day as the Governor may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint and different days may be so appointed for different purposes.

**Amendment to section 44.**

2. Section 44 of the Magistrates' Court Ordinance (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance") is amended in sub-section (1)-

Magistrates' Court (Amendment) Ordinance, 1993.

- (a) by omitting the words "have power in its discretion to make such" and substituting therefor the words "make an";
- (b) by omitting the words "as it thinks" and substituting therefor the words "unless to do so would not be".

**Amendment to section 65.**

3. Section 65 of the principal Ordinance is amended-

- (a) by omitting the final fullstop and substituting therefor a colon;
- (b) by inserting the following proviso-

"Provided that this section shall not apply to a complaint made under section 57 in respect of default in paying a sum ordered to be paid by the magistrates' court under the Maintenance Ordinance."
