**SUPREME COURT ACT**

**SUPREME COURT (AMENDMENT) RULES 2011**

In exercise of powers conferred by section 38 of the Supreme Court Act and all other enabling provisions, the Chief Justice has made the following Rules—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Amendment) Rules 2011 and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the Gazette.

**Amendment of the Supreme Court Rules 2000.**

2. The Supreme Court Rules 2000 are amended as follows—

(a) for sub-rule (2) of rule 4 substitute—

“(2) There shall be three sittings in each year, that is to say—

(a) the Michaelmas sittings, which shall begin on the second Monday of September and end on 20th December;

(b) the Hilary sittings, which shall begin on 7th January and end on the Saturday before Good Friday;

(c) the Trinity sittings, which shall begin on the second Monday after Easter Sunday and end on the second Monday of June.

(3) The Chief Justice may by notice in the Gazette amend the dates which appear in sub-rule (2).”;

(b) in rule 5(1)(b) for “2.30 pm” substitute “1.00 pm”; and

(c) after rule 5(2) insert–

“(3) The Chief Justice may by notice in the Gazette amend the times which appear in sub-rule (1).”.
