SUPREME COURT ACT

**SOLICITORS' (PRACTISING CERTIFICATES) (AMENDMENT)
RULES, 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 38 of the Supreme Court Act the Chief Justice has made the following rules of court—

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These rules may be cited as the Solicitors (Practising Certificates) (Amendment) Rules, 2014.

(2) These rules come into operation on 1st May 2014.

Amendment of rule 5 of the Solicitors (Practising Certificates) Rules, 2005.

2. For rule 5(1) of the Solicitors (Practising Certificates) Rules, 2005 (Professional Indemnity Insurance) substitute—

“(1) Every solicitor is required to take out and maintain professional indemnity insurance in the minimum sum set by the Chief Justice from time to time by notice in the Gazette.”.

Transitional provision.

3. The minimum sum set by the Chief Justice in accordance with rule 5(1) of the Solicitors (Practising Certificates) Rules, 2005 (Professional Indemnity Insurance) shall, until such time as a notice is published in accordance with that rule, be deemed to be “£1,000,000 each claim and in the aggregate”.
