**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Criminal Offences Ordinance and for matters consequential thereto.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Offences Ordinance (Amendment) Ordinance 2000.

**Amendment to the Criminal Offences Ordinance.**

1. The Criminal Offences Ordinance shall be amended by substituting for section 21(2) the following subsection -

“(2) A person who commits treason is guilty of an offence and upon conviction on indictment shall be sentenced to imprisonment for life.”.

**Consequential amendments.**

2. The Criminal Procedure Ordinance shall be amended by repealing sections 166 to 170.
