Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Offences Ordinance (Amendment) Ordinance 2000.

Amendment to the Criminal Offences Ordinance.

- 1. The Criminal Offences Ordinance shall be amended by substituting for section 21(2) the following subsection -
 - "(2) A person who commits treason is guilty of an offence and upon conviction on indictment shall be sentenced to imprisonment for life.".

Consequential amendments.

2.	The Criminal	Procedure	Ordinance	shall	be	amended	by	repealing
sections	166 to 170.
