AN ORDINANCE to amend the Criminal Offences Ordinance to prevent the feeding of the Rock Apes by unauthorised persons.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Offences (Amendment) Ordinance 2002.

Amendment to the Criminal Offences Ordinance.

2. Section 271 of the Criminal Offences Ordinance is replaced by-

“Feeding of Rock apes.

271. A person who encourages the rock apes to come down from the Upper Rock or who, not being a person authorised by the Minister with responsibility for tourism, feeds them at any place is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 3 on the standard scale.”.
