AN ORDINANCE to amend the Education Ordinance

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990.

Amendment to Section 50.

2. The Education Ordinance (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance") is amended' in Section 50 as follows:

- (a) by omitting the word "It" at the beginning of the section and substituting therefor the word "it"; and

- (b) by inserting at the beginning of the section immediately before such word, the words "Subject to the provisions of section 73".

Amendment to Section 73.

3. The principal Ordinance is further amended in Section 73 as follows:

- (a) in sub-section (1) by omitting the words "of a parent resident" and substituting the word "residing";
- (b) by omitting sub-section (2) and substituting the following new sub-section—

"(2) For the purpose of such-section (1) a child shall be deemed to be residing in Gibraltar only if he is in Gibraltar under the provisions of the Immigration Control Ordinance, and—

- (i) does not require a permit or certificate to Gibraltar; or reside in
- (ii) has a certificate of permanent residence; or
- (iii) has a valid permit of residence issued under Section 18(1)(f) of the immigration Control Ordinance."
