**EDUCATION ORDINANCE.**

**EDUCATION (NATIONAL CURRICULUM) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1994.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 82 of the Education Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations -

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (National Curriculum) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994.

**Amendment to regulation 2.**

2. Regulation 2 of the Education (National Curriculum) Regulations 1991 is amended in the interpretation of "Foundation subjects" -

- (a) in paragraph (a) by omitting the semi-colon at the end of subparagraph (i), and substituting there for a colon and inserting the following proviso -

"Provided that Technology shall not be a Foundation Subject for pupils entering Key Stage four in September 1994 and September 1995;"

- (b) by omitting paragraph (c);

- (c) in paragraph (d) -

- (i) by omitting the words "Stages three and four" and substituting therefor the words "Stage three";

- (ii) by omitting the final fullstop and substituting therefor a semi-colon.
