**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Employment Ordinance.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Employment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

**Amendment of section 18.**

2. Section 18(1) of the Employment Ordinance (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance") is amended in the definition of "permit" by inserting after the word "permit" the following "(except in section 26A)".

**New section 26A.**

3. The principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after Section 26 the following new section –

**“Detached workers.**

26A. (1) In this section "detached worker" means workers a person who-

(a) is not ordinarily resident in Gibraltar, and

(b) is in employment in a country outside Gibraltar,

and is required by his employer to perform work of a temporary nature in Gibraltar in the course of his employment.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 20 to 26, if the Director is satisfied that the conditions specified in subsection (3) are fulfilled with respect to any detached worker, he may at his discretion grant a permit under this section to or in respect of that detached worker.

(3) The conditions mentioned in subsection (2) are

(a) that the kind of work that the detached worker is required to perform is of a specialized nature and no person having the necessary skill and experience is available in Gibraltar to perform that work; and

(b) that the detached worker is not required to replace, and carry on the work of another detached worker whose permit under this section has expired or is about to expire; and

(c) that the detached worker is insured under the law relating to social insurance in the country of his

employment which entitles him to benefits not less favourable than corresponding benefits provided for by the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Ordinance.

- (4) While a permit granted under this section remains valid the provisions of sections 25 and 26 shall be deemed to have been complied with regarding the detached worker to, or in respect of when the permit was granted, without any further formality.
- (5) A permit under this section shall be valid for such period, not exceeding four weeks, as shall be specified in the permit, but may be revoked by the Director, at his discretion, at any time.
- (6) Any decision by the Director to grant, refuse or revoke a permit under this section shall be final.
- (7) The grant of a permit under this section shall be subject to the payment of a fee of £20 and if the permit is granted to or in respect of more than one detached worker, the fee shall be £20 each.”.

**Amendment of Section 52.**

4. Section 51(6)(a) of the principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the expression "£1,500" and substituting therefor the expression "£8.883”.
