**REGULATION OF WAGES AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT
ORDINANCE.
(Cap. 139).**

**CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT (RETAIL DISTRIBUTIVE
TRADE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1985.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 8 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor having received a conditions of employment recommendation from the Regulation of Conditions of Employment Board, has made the following order:

Title and commencement.

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Conditions of Employment (Retail Distributive Trade) (Amendment) Order, 1985.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of June, 1985.

Amendment of paragraph 2 of L.N. No. 142 Of 1980.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Conditions of Employment (Retail Distributive Trade) Order, 1980 (hereinafter called the principal order) is amended by omitting the definition of the term "retail distributive trade" and substituting therefor the following new definition:

" "retail distributive trade" means the sale by retail of any class of goods; and also means the business of receiving articles for dry cleaning and dyeing and their return (but does not mean the process of dry cleaning or dyeing); and also means the business of a hairdresser and barber; and also means the business of hiring out pre-recorded video cassettes;"

Amendment of paragraph 4.

3. Paragraph 4 of the principal order is amended by revoking sub-paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following sub-paragraph:

"Minimum remuneration. 4. (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph 5 and 6 of this order, the minimum weekly remuneration payable to employees to whom this order applies shall be as follows:

<i>Grade</i>	<i>Age</i>	<i>Remuneration</i>
Sales assistants,	Under 18	£45.74
warehouse workers,	18 and over	£52.78
clerks, cashiers,	19 and over	£59.81
and other employees employed in retail shops	20 and over	£70.35
