ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005

ENVIRONMENT (WASTE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 18 of the Environment Act 2005, and in order to transpose into the Law of Gibraltar Directive (EU) 2018/849 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 amending Council Directives 2000/53/EC on end-of life vehicles, 2006/66/EC on batteries and accumulators and waste batteries and accumulators, and 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment, the Government has made the following Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Environment (Waste) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the date of publication.

Amendment to Regulations.

- 3.(1) The Environment (Waste) Regulations 2007 are amended in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.
 - (2) In regulation 11, substitute subregulation (3) in its entirety with-
 - "(3) The Competent Authority shall, in accordance with the timescales, periods and format set out in Articles 16(6) and 16(7) of the WEEE Directive, communicate to the European Commission a report on the implementation of the WEEE Directive in Gibraltar and the information set out in regulation 11(2)(f)."
 - (3) In regulation 14J(7)-
 - (a) the word "electronically" is inserted before the word "transmit";
 - (b) the words "six months" are replaced with "eighteen months";
 - (c) the words "the calendar year for which the report relates" are replaced with "the reporting year for which the data are collected".

- (4) After regulation 14L(3) insert the following new subregulation-
 - "(4) The Competent Authority shall electronically transmit reports to the Commission within eighteen months of the end of the reporting year for which the data in respect of whether the recycling efficiencies referred to in Annex III Part B of the Batteries Directive have been met.".
- (5) Regulation 14T is deleted in its entirety.
