EXPORT CONTROL ACT 2005

EXPORT CONTROL (SANCTIONS ETC) ORDER 2014

In exercise of his powers under sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Export Control Act 2005, the Minister has made the following Order–

Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Sanctions etc) Order 2014.

Amendment to Schedule 4 of the Export Control (Sanctions Etc.) Order 2005.

2. Schedule 4 to the Export Control (Sanctions etc) Order 2005 is amended under the Heading "Belarus" by replacing the text and list of names with the following-

"Persons and entities listed in Council Regulation (EU) 765/2006 as amended from time to time.
