NOTICE OF AMENDMENT (No.12)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 3(4) of the Ukraine (Sanctions) (No.2) Order 2014, I have issued the following Notice-

This Notice amends the Ukraine (Sanctions) (No.2) Order 2014 for the purposes of implementing Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/1514 of 14 September 2015 implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine.
