EXPORT CONTROL (SANCTIONS ETC.) ORDER 2006

**EXPORT CONTROL (SANCTIONS ETC.)
(AMENDMENT NO.11) ORDER 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9 of the Export Control Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, and for the purposes of implementing Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/466 of 31 March 2016, implementing Article 21(2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/44 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, the Minister has made the following Order—

Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Sanctions etc.) (Amendment No.11) Order 2016.

Commencement.

2. This Order comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to Schedule 4 of the Export Control (Sanctions etc.) Order 2006.

3. Schedule 4 of the Export Control (Sanctions etc.) Order 2006 is amended after the heading “**LIBYA**” by adding the following persons to the list of persons below the heading “**COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) 2016/44—ANNEX III**”—

AL GHWEIL, Khalifa AL-GHAWAIL, Khalifa</p>	<p>d.o.b. 1964 Misratah</p>	<p>Khalifa Ghwell is the so-called “Prime Minister and Defence Minister” of the internationally unrecognised General National Congress (“GNC”) (also known as the “National Salvation Government”), and as such is responsible for their activities.</p> <p>On 7 July 2015 Khalifa Ghwell showed his support for the Steadfastness Front (Alsomood), a new military force of 7 brigades to prevent a unity government from forming in Tripoli, by attending the signing ceremony to inaugurate the force with GNC “President” Nuri Abu Sahmain.</p>	

		<p>As GNC “Prime Minister” Ghwell has played a central role in obstructing the establishment of the GNA established under the Libya Political Agreement.</p> <p>On 15 January 2016, in his capacity as the Tripoli GNC’s “Prime minister and Minister of Defence”, Ghwell ordered the arrest of any members of the new Security Team, appointed by the prime minister designate of the Government of National Accord, who set foot in Tripoli.</p>
