NOTICE OF AMENDMENT (NO.17)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph 3(4) of the Ukraine Sanctions (No2.) Order 2014, I have issued the following Notice-

The Schedule to the Ukraine (Sanctions) (No.2) Order 2014 is amended as follows-

- (a) the entries for individuals “Gennadiy Nikolaiovych TSYPKALOV” and “Arseny Sergeevich PAVLOV” are deleted; and
- (b) by replacing all the entries corresponding to persons, entities and bodies with the following-
