		On 28 July 2016, President Putin appointed him as the acting "Governor of Sevastopol". In this capacity, he has worked for further integration of the illegally annexed Crimean peninsula into the Russian Federation, and is as such responsible for actively supporting or implementing actions or policies which undermine or threaten the territorial integrity, sovereignty, and independence of Ukraine.	
		In 2017 he made public statements supporting the illegal annexation of Crimea and Sevastopol and on the	
		anniversary of the illegal "Crimean referendum". He commemorated the veterans

of the so-called "self-defence units" that facilitated the deployment of Russian forces on the Crimean peninsula in
