In exercise of the powers conferred on him by and pursuant to sections 43(1) and (2) of the European Arrest Warrant Act, section 2 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act and section 38 of the Supreme Court Act, the Acting Chief Justice has made the following Rules–

Title.

1. These Rules may be cited as the European Arrest Warrant (Appeals) Rules 2008.

Time limit for hearing appeals.

2. The Supreme Court must begin to hear an appeal under section 38 or 40 of the European Arrest Warrant Act within 90 days starting on the date that the appellant was arrested under the relevant European arrest warrant.
