FAIR TRADING ACT 2015

FAIR TRADING (FORMS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 91 and sections 60(3), 61(3), 73(2) and 88(1) of the Fair Trading Act 2015, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for commercial and consumer affairs has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fair Trading (Forms) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and enter into force on the day of publication.

Amendment of Fair Trading (Forms) Regulations 2015.

2. The Fair Trading (Forms) Regulations 2015 are amended in accordance with these Regulations.
