In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 91 and subsections 60(3), 61(3), 73(2) and 88(1) of the Fair Trading Act 2015, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for commercial and consumer affairs has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fair Trading (Forms) Regulations 2015 and shall take effect and come into operation as law on their date of publication.

Application for a new licence.

- 2.(1) A notice of intention to apply for a new licence shall be as set out in Form 1a of Schedule 1.
- (2) An application for a new licence once the relevant notice of intention has been published shall be as set out in Form 2a of Schedule 2.
- (3) A notice of objection to the grant of a new licence shall be as set out in Form 3a of Schedule 3.

Application for extension to scope of licence.

- 3.(1) Notice of intention to apply for an extension to the scope of a licence shall be as set out in Form 1b of Schedule 1.
- (2) An application for an extension to the scope of a licence once the relevant notice of intention has been published shall be as set out in Form 2b of Schedule 2.
- (3) A notice of objection to the extension to the scope of a licence shall be as set out in Form 3b of Schedule 3.

Application for the transfer of a licence to other premises.

- 4.(1) Notice of intention to apply for the transfer of a licence to other premises shall be as set out in Form 1c of Schedule 1.
- (2) An application for the transfer of a licence to other premises once the relevant notice of intention has been published shall be as set out in Form 2c of Schedule 2.
