Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 2022.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Fees.

3. The following fees are payable in respect of the matters provided for under the Act-

(a)	Fee for a new licence for a single business class	£162
(b)	Fee for the renewal of an existing licence with a single business class	£108
(c)	Fee for a provisional licence – start ups	£102.50
(d)	Fee for each additional business class included on new licence	£97
(e)	Fee for extending scope of an existing licence by each additional business class	£97
(f)	Fee for transfer of licence to other premises	£97
(g)	Fee for transfer whilst licence remains on the same premises	£97
(h)	Objection filing fee	£97
(i)	Fee for each additional business class included on a renewal for an existing licence	£65
(j)	Fee for duplicate licence	£38
(k)	Inspection of register	£5.50

Revocation.

4. The Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 2015 are revoked.
