## Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 20242024/113

In exercise of the powers conferred upon her by sections 51,111 and 112 of the Fair Trading Act 2023, the Minister has made the following Regulations–

#### Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 2024.

#### Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on 1 August 2024.

#### Fees.

3. The following fees shall be payable in connection with the exercise of the OFT's functions under or as a result of the Act, namely–

Description of fee	Amount of

1. On the issue of a new licence:	
(i) for a single business licence;	£179.50
(ii) for trade business class and a service business class	£256.50
subject to the deduction of fees already paid in obtaining provisional approval for that licence.	
2. On the issuance of a licence or renewal of a licence to carry on any of the businesses referred to in section 30(1).	£61.50
3. On the extension of a licence by adding another business class or activities to a licence.	£112.50
4. On the renewal of an existing licence with:	
(i) a single business class;	£112.50
(ii) a trade and service business class.	£205.00
5. On the provisional appeal for the grant of a new licence.	£112.50
6. On the issue of a temporary licence.	£256.50

#### Waiver for applicants aged 21 years or less.

3A. The OFT may waive the fees in regulation 3 where the OFT is satisfied that the beneficial owner of a significant or controlling interest in the applicant business is an individual or individuals aged 21 years or less.

4. The Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 2023 are revoked.

#### Savings.

5. The revocation of the Fair Trading (Fees) Regulations 2023 by regulation 4 does not affect any liability to pay any fees under those regulations.
