BANKING ORDINANCE 1992

BANKING (FEES AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 79 of the Banking Ordinance 1992 and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations—

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Banking (Fees Amendment) Regulations 2002.

Amendment to Schedule 3 of the Banking Regulations 1992.

2. Schedule 3 of the Banking Regulations 1992 is replaced with—

“SCHEDULE 3

FEES	Regulation 5
1. Initial administration fee where the Commissioner receives a notice under section 7(1) or (2) of the Ordinance	£ 3000
2. Continuation administration fee on each anniversary of the date of the receipt of the notice under section 7(1) or (2) of the Ordinance	£ 3000
3. Penalty fee where an initial administration fee or a continuation administration fee is not paid or paid after it becomes due and payable (the penalty fee being payable in addition to that other fee).	£ 300
4. Fee for an application under section 18	£ 8000
