AN ORDINANCE to amend the Insurance Companies Ordinance 1987 to provide for the licensing and regulating of insurance companies who carry on business from within Gibraltar.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Insurance Companies (Amendment) Ordinance 2005.

(2) This Ordinance comes into operation on 1 July 2005.

Amendments to the Insurance Companies Ordinance.

2. The Insurance Companies Ordinance 1987 is amended by inserting “or from within” between “in” and “Gibraltar” in the following places–

- (a) in section 6(1);
- (b) in section 16A(1);
- (c) in section 17(1);
- (d) in section 23(1);
- (e) in section 70C(3) (on the first occasion “in Gibraltar” appears);
- (f) in section 75A(1);
- (g) in section 101(1)(a);
- (h) in section 106(1)(b).
