**INSURANCE COMPANIES (PRESCRIBED PARTICULARS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 118 of the Insurance Companies Act 1987, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for financial services has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance Companies (Prescribed Particulars) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and come into operation on the date of publication.

Amendment of regulation 3.

2. Regulation 3 of the Insurance Companies (Prescribed Particulars) Regulations 1996 shall be amended as follows—

- (a) in sub-regulation (1)(b), after “a company” insert “, including a protected cell company,”; and
- (b) in sub regulation (3), after “protected cell companies” insert “carrying on general insurance and reinsurance business only”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations provide that the fees payable by protected cell companies applying for a licence to carry on insurance business will be determined by whether they seek to carry on long term or general insurance business.
