**FOOD AND DRUGS. EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES ORDINANCE.**

**NATURAL MINERAL WATERS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,  
1988.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the European Communities Ordinance and of all other enabling powers the Governor has made the following regulations:

**Title and commencement.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Natural Mineral Waters (Amendment) Regulations 1988 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1988.

**Amendment of the Natural Mineral Waters Regulations 1988.**

2. The Natural Mineral Waters Regulations 1988 are amended-

(1) in regulation 2 by deleting the definition of 'authorised officer' and substituting the following definition-

"'authorised officer' means an authorised officer of the Government and for the purposes of these regulations has the meaning otherwise assigned to it by section 31 of the Food and Drugs Ordinance but does not include the Chief Environmental Health Officer;"

(2) in regulation 2, in the definition of 'natural mineral water' by deleting the expression "paragraph (1), (2) or (5)" and substituting the expression "sub-regulation (1) or (2)";

(3) in regulation 2, in the definition of 'public analyst' by deleting the word "Ordinances" and substituting the word "Ordinance";

(4) in regulation 4(4), by deleting the expression "or on the Director of Medical and Health Services, direction in accordance with paragraph (5) of this regulation,";

(5) by deleting regulation 4(5); and

(6) by renumbering regulation 4(6) as regulation 4(5). Dated this
