In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 8 of the Freedom of Information Act 2018, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Freedom of Information (Fees) Regulations 2021.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Fees.

- 3.(1) For the purpose of section 8 of the Act, the following fee and charge is prescribed in relation to an application for access to information-
 - (a) an application fee of £10; and
 - (b) subject to subregulations (3) and (4), a charge equal to the estimated cost of the search for and retrieval of the information concerned calculated at a rate of £10 per hour per person.
- (2) For the purpose of determining the estimated cost of the search for and retrieval of the information concerned, the public authority may take into account time spent-
 - (a) determining whether it holds the information;
 - (b) locating the information, or a document which may contain the information;
 - (c) retrieving the information, or a document which may contain the information;
 - (d) extracting the information from a document or documents containing it;
 - (e) communicating the information to the applicant.
- (3) No fee is to be charged under subregulation (1)(b) where the estimated cost of the search for and retrieval of the information concerned is £100 or less.
 - (4) The maximum amount that may be charged under subregulation (1)(b) is £500.
