With the transfer to the Government of the functions of the former City Council, completed by the City Council (Abolition and Transfer of Functions - Final Provisions) Regulations 1970, the City Council Act (Act. 1921-10) became spent, except for s.31, which had been inserted by Act. 1960-33 and which provided for the conferring of the Freedom of the City.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMISSION OF HONORARY FREEMEN OF THE CITY.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Freedom of the City Act.

Admission of freemen.

2. The Government may, following a resolution of the Parliament, admit to be honorary freemen of the City of Gibraltar persons of distinction and persons who have rendered eminent services to the City.
