Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Fees) Order.

Fees payable.

2. The fees prescribed in the Schedule shall be payable in respect of the licences and permits issued in respect of the matters specified therein.

Annual fees.

3. A betting shop licence, a bookmaker's permit and a betting agency permit shall be valid from the date on which it is expressed to come into force until the next following 31st day of March.

Reduced fees.

4. Where any licence or permit referred to in paragraph 3 is taken out after the 1st day of April, the fee therefor shall be reduced by one-twelfth part for each complete calendar month which has elapsed between the preceding 1st day of April and the date of issue of the licence.

SCHEDULE

Item	Fee
1. Betting Shop Licence (section 11(1)(a).)	£50 per annum
2. Bookmaker's Permit (Section 11(1)(b).)	£20 per annum
3. Betting Agency Permit Section 11(1)(c).)	£5 per annum
4. Bingo, Tombola or Housie-Housie (Section 18(1).)	£1 per session, from 5 a.m. on one day to 5 a.m. on the day next following
5. Lotteries at public fairs, those referred to in Item 1 of the Schedule to the Act, and those referred to in Item 2 of such Schedule when promoted for charitable purposes to the satisfaction of the Financial and Development Secretary. (Section 11(1).)	No charge.
6. Euro lottery Gibraltar Limited. (Section 18(1).)	one per cent on the value of the tickets sales
7. Globalot Limited (Section 18(1).)	£10,000 per annum
8. Lotteries other than those specified in items 4, 5, 6 and 7 above (Section 18(1).)	10% on the value of the lottery, that is to say, on the total number of tickets comprised in the lottery multiplied by the price of each ticket.
