GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

GIBRALTAR REGIMENT COLOURS CROWN COIN NOTICE 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice – $\,$

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as Gibraltar Regiment Colours Crown Coin Notice, 1998.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (this is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of a helmeted soldier of the Gibraltar Regiment bearing the keys of the City and Fortress of Gibraltar flanked by the new Regimental

Colours of the Gibraltar Regiment with the Regimental Badge depicted above his head and, in the background, the outline of the Rock of Gibraltar together with the inscription "THE GIBRALTAR REGIMENT NEW COLOURS 1ST JULY 1998" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
