#### **GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990**

### MARRIAGE OF H.R.H. PRINCE EDWARD AND SOPHIE RHYS-JONES COIN NOTICE 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, I have issued the following notice -

#### Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Marriage of H.R.H. Prince Edward and Sophie Rhys-Jones Crown Coin Notice, 1999.

#### Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said part of the Schedule.

# Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -
  - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
  - (b) the reverse impression shall bear -

- (i) the design of a portrait of H.R.H. Prince Edward and Sophie Rhys-Jones with a banner of roses and wedding bells together with the inscriptions "JUNE 19TH 1999" and "THE WEDDING OF THE PRINCE EDWARD & MISS SOPHIE RHYS-JONES" and the value of the coin; or
- (ii) a design of St. George's Chapel, Windsor Castle with two doves flying overhead and a garland of wedding bells beneath with two interwined hearts together with the inscriptions "JUNE 19TH 1999" and "THE WEDDING OF THE PRINCE EDWARD & MISS SOPHIE RHYS-JONES" and the value of the coin.

## Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
